Red Gate Farm is offering an exciting opportunity to young, aspiring filmmakers. Students will be working for three weeks on creating a short film. Elements that will be covered include script writing, film planning, camera work, sound recording, basic editing, special effects and final presentation. At the end of the session, students will present their finished projects during a special screening night for families and friends. Completed films will also be eligible for entry in the 3rd Annual Ashfield FilmFest.

Students will work in a collaborative environment that is as much fun as it is interesting. We are also inviting some film and production professionals to share their stories and help students with their projects. Red Gate Farm will provide the digital video equipment and computer stations for student work.

### Program Instructors

**Harry Keramidas** is a professional motion picture editor and has also worked on over fifty documentary films. He currently serves on the Ashfield FilmFest committee.

**Ben Murray** is the Director of Red Gate Farm and a local filmmaker. He has made several short films and won awards in the past two Ashfield FilmFests.

### State Health Regulations Require:

Campers and staff **under 18yrs**:

**MMR:** 1<sup>st</sup> dose = 12 mos or older,

**Measles:** 2<sup>nd</sup> dose = grades K-12 or age equiv

**Polio:** 3 doses IPV or OPV, or

4 doses mix IPV/ OPV

**Diphtheria and Tetanus Toxoids and Pertussis\*:**

4 doses DTaP/DTP/DT or,

3 doses of Td

(persons 7 yrs or older needing additional vaccines to comply with above, Td is to be used)

\*Booster dose of Td:

-grades 7-10 need booster if >5yrs since last dose of DTaP/DTP/DT

-grades 11-12 need booster if more than 10 yrs since last dose of DTaP/DTP/DT/Td

Hep B: **3 doses if born on or after 1/1/92**
