

Part-Time Teacher (hourly, April - October)

Job Description

Part-time teachers work closely with our full-time lead teachers and provide important teaching support for our programs and visiting students as they work on and explore the farm. Teachers guide and work alongside students doing hands-on work around the farm. Typical work might include cleaning stalls, working with animals, weeding and harvesting in the garden, cutting down brush, and many other farm-related tasks.

- Must be able to work in a farm environment with a variety of livestock types (training provided)
